WyomingPBS and the Sublette County Public Library will be hosting a screening of *Glaciers of the Winds*, a locally produced film documenting the scientific exploration and retreat of the Wind River glaciers. The event is free and open to the public. A Q&A featuring producer Kyle Nicholoff will follow the screening. Light snacks will be served.

About the documentary:

The Wind Rivers slash across 120 miles of west-central Wyoming. They're home to more than 40 named peaks over 13,000 feet and seven of the largest glaciers in the American Rockies. *Glaciers of the Winds* documents the scientific exploration and retreat of these glaciers. Many of the Wind River's glaciers are hundreds of feet thick and supply major water systems on both sides of the continental divide. Glacier runoff gives life not only to agriculture but also to the plants and animals in the region. The glaciers of the Winds have been shrinking at an accelerated rate over the last forty years. WyomingPBS explores how glacial retreat could have significant effects on the local ecosystem and downstream farms and ranches.
